CLUB HISTORY

The Westfield Woman's Club was founded in 1914. The objectives of the Club as stated are: "To broaden and strengthen the moral, social and Intellectual life of its members, and through them make Itself a power in the community." Later, this was added: "To establish, erect and maintain a Club House for civic, benevolent and social uses."

Our Club has a Constitution and By-Laws. We are governed by an Executive Board consisting of seven Officers and eight Directors. Elections are held at the annual meeting In May, and any active Club member may hold office.

GENERAL CLUB MEETINGS

General Club meetings are held in the dining hall on the first Wednesday of each month, October through May, omitting January; and will be held on the following day if school is canceled for severe weather.

A luncheon is served to all members, guests, and prospective members at a cost of \$20.00 per person.

A program normally follows each luncheon.
